Fascinating Receipt Book from the Early 1800's Including a Receipt for a Slave Purchase, as Well as a Receipt for the Purchase of the Sloop "Harlequin" The receipt book is leather bound and reads in part: "Received New York March the 1st day 1800 of Samuel Pine Two Hundred and Eight dollars 34/100 in full for his Third part of the first payment of the sloop Harlequin..." October the fifth 1803 Received of Samuel Pine the sum of two hundred dollars in full for a Black boy by me Richard Willis". This item comes with a Certificate from John Reznikoff, a premier authenticator for both major 3rd party authentication services, PSA and JSA (James Spence Authentications), as well as numerous auction houses.

Received New York March the 29th day 1800 of Samuel Pine Three Hundred and Eighty Eight Dollars 38/100 in full for his third part of the first payment of the Sloop Harlequin — Wm. J. Moore
